To whom it may concern

Japan Remote Control Co. Ltd. would like to make it clear that we do not supply JR Propo radio control products or JR Heli Division helicopter products to Probuild Aircraft Limited.

In the United Kingdom we only supply our products to our exclusive UK distributor MacGregor Industries Limited.

Probuild Aircraft Ltd. have chosen not to purchase JR products from MacGregor and are buying them from an unofficial source. We have taken steps to stop their supply of grey imported products and will actively find and stop any similar unofficial supply lines in the future.

We are most concerned that Probuild is advertising DSX series radio systems. It is impossible for them to sell CE approved JR DSX9 and DSX12 sets since we only ship CE approved versions to MacGregor Industries. We do not sell CE versions to any other market than MacGregor in the UK.

Therefore we do not support Probuild's claims to have legitimate CE certification and CE marks for the sets they sell. To get full CE certification, as has been done with all MacGregor sets, requires a high level of technical information that Probuild cannot legitimately possess.

Please also bear in mind that the specification of our products varies from country to country. So if you buy a grey import, you may not get the same product that MacGregor stock. This may affect their ability to help you if you ever need support or spare parts.

UK modellers should only buy JR products from a genuine JR/MacGregor stockist. Only then will you get genuine CE approved products, with full support from both MacGregor Industries and Japan Remote Control Co. Ltd.
